INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Definitions:

- (i) "The purchaser" means the DBT-APSCS&T Centre of Excellence for Bioresources and Sustainable Development, Komasaki, Kimin, District Papumpare, Arunachal Pradesh.
- (ii) "The bidder" means the individual or firm who participates in this tender and submits its bid.
- (iii) "The supplier" means the individual or firm providing supply under contract.
- (iv) The Services means all the Services, which the supplier is required to provide to the purchaser under the contract.
- (v) Letter of Acceptance (LOA) means the written communication to the successful bidder from the purchaser to accept the tender as per the terms & conditions contained & referred therein.
- (vi) "The Purchase/Work Order" means the written order placed by the purchaser on the supplier signed by purchaser including all section incorporated by reference therein. The purchase/work order shall be deemed as "Contract" appearing in the document.
- (vii) "The contract Price" means the price payable to the supplier under the purchase order/work order for the full & proper compliance of his contractual obligations.
- (viii) The records, terms & expressions not specifically defined herein or in the tender documents, shall have the same meaning assigned to them, as the case may be. The Head notes are for guidance only & shall not affect the interpretation or construction of any provision thereof in the tender documents.
- (ix) Date of receipt of communication of purchase/work order will be taken as actual date of receipt or 15 days from date of dispatch in case of postal delivery; whichever is earlier unless specifically mentioned.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- (i) Bidder must be a company that should be registered with Registrar of Companies.
- (ii) The bidder shall submit Detailed Drawing of the Project along with the proposal/offer.
- (iii) The Bid proposal shall be sealed and the bid inviting Memo No. should be super scribed at the top of the sealed cover.
- (iv) Quoted price: The bidder should quote the price of items separately along with relevant papers for supporting the quoted price such as catalogue, user list etc. failing which the bid shall be treated as non-responsive at the discretion of the purchaser.
- (v) The documents submitted by the bidder should remain valid for a period of 180 Days w.e.f. the date of submission of the bid. Bid not conforming to this provision shall be treated as non-responsive.
- (vi) The rate should be quoted inclusive of all deliverables, duties, taxes and other levies payable by the bidder included in the item rate.
- (vii) Bidders must supply the items at their own cost. All Machineries/Equipments are to be supplied FOR, Project Area. Delivery of goods shall have to be completed within 90 days from the date of issuing of work/supply order.
- (viii) Installation and commissioning charges, if any, inclusive of expenses of foundation work etc. are to be mentioned separately against each machine. In case of no mention, the same will be considered as inclusive of installation cost wherever applicable.
- (ix) Rates should be quoted clearly both in words and figures separately for each item without which the quotation shall stand rejected. In case of any ambiguity for the amount specified between words and figure, the amount specified in words shall be considered final.
- (x) The warranty of the project shall be as per the prevailing warranty policy/warranty certificate of the

manufacturer (wherever necessary) for the items, machinery/Equipments and warranty period shall not be less than one (1) year from the date of commissioning of the items, unit at site. Post installation operation of the facilities by the bidder for minimum two months period with all material (plants without seed) as a part of the project.

- (xi) Detailed specification with model, size, code no., catalogue and name of manufacturer should be furnished.
- (xii) Copies of S.S.I. registration or such documents may be produced with the offer.
- (xiii) Up to date Sales Tax Clearance Certificate, Income Tax Return of last three (3) years, and PAN No. duly attested must be furnished along with the offer.
- (xiv) The bidder organization/firm must have scientists with Ph. D degree minimum for the following disciplines: 1) Horticulture, 2) Plant Biotechnology, 3) Floriculture 4) Plant Protection, mainly. Their CV to be enclosed with the offer.
- (xv) The bidder should have a wide experience of designing, supply and running of the project in all manners includes all machine fixing, orientation, synchronization, adjustments, MEP works etc. The firm should have a proper plan of safety majors at construction site under ESH guidelines.
- (xvi) All accessories required for full and proper functioning of the equipment(s) should be included along with the quoted unit price, not as separate accessories such as Sensor, Voltage stabilizer, Computer, Software etc.
- (xvii) Temporary Electricity and Water connection have to be arranged by the firm from the existing Electricity and Water facility available at the site during construction. The firm should bear the charges, if any for the same.
- (xviii) Bid must also be submitted in a soft copy (to support in Word format only) in the following format failing which the bid treated as non-responsive, at the discretions of the purchaser. In case of any optional items, pictures should be show separately. Any discrepancies in the soft copy will be the responsibility of the bidder.

3. **Cost of Bidding**

The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the bid to DBT-APSCS&T Centre of Excellence for Bioresources and Sustainable Development, Kimin and in no case the CoE will be responsible for these costs regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

4. **Bid Document**

- (i) This document consists of following sections:
 - (a) Notice Inviting Tender (NIT)- Section I
 - (b) Instructions to Bidders - Section II
 - (c) General (Commercial) Conditions of Contract - Section III
 - (d) Technical Specification /Schedule of Requirement - Section IV
 - (e) Format of Letter of Acceptance - Section V
 - (f) Format for Agreement – Section VI
 - (g) Format for Affidavit - VII
 - (h) Bidder’s Detail - Section VIII
 - (i) Check list - Section IX
 - (j) Declaration regarding Non tampered Tender Documents-Section X
 - (k) Declaration regarding Blacklisting/Non-Blacklisting - Section XI
 - (l) Declaration regarding Acceptance to the Terms & Conditions of the tender – Section XII

- (ii) The bidder is required to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the Bid document. Failure to furnish all or any of the information required as per Bid document or submission of the bids not being substantive may result in rejection of the bid.
- (iii) A prospective bidder requiring any clarification on the Bid documents shall have to intimate this office in writing. This office shall respond in writing to any such request which it receives not later than 3 days prior to the date of closing of Tender.

5. Amendment to bid document

- (i) At any time, prior to the date of submission of Bids, CoE, Kimin may, for any reason, whether on its own initiative or in response to any clarification sought by a bidder, shall modify bid documents by amendments and the same will be uploaded on the portal and these amendments will be binding on bidders.
- (ii) In order to afford prospective bidders a reasonable time to take the amendment in to account in preparing their bids, the CoE may, at its discretion, shall extend the deadline for the submission of bids suitably. Any amendment to the Bid document shall also be uploaded in the web site as and when it is made.
- (iii) Bidders who download the Bid document through internet are to take care of these amendments while submitting their bids.

6. Bid Form

The bidder must complete the Bidder's Detail as per Section VIII and enclose with the bid documents.

7. Bid Price:

- (i) Instructions for Filling of Technical & Financial Bid are given in Section II, III & IV.
- (ii) The rates quoted by the tenderer must be reasonable & logical. The tender can be rejected on the basis of unreasonable or illogical rates.
- (iii) Bid Price shall be quoted inclusive of applicable taxes, duties, levies etc. Wages and applicable statutory taxes, duties, levies etc. will be reimbursed by the purchaser. However, at the time of claiming, taxes, duties and levies etc. applicable should be specifically indicated in the bills. Copies of notifications issued by authorities concerned specifying applicability & rates should be submitted to the purchaser along with the first bill and subsequently in case of any changes.
- (iv) The price quoted by the bidder shall remain fixed during entire period of contract and shall not be subject to variation. A bid submitted with an adjustable price quotation will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.

8. Earnest Money/Security Deposit:

- (i) The Earnest Money/Security Deposit is required to protect the Purchaser's interests against the risk of bidder's conduct, which would warrant forfeiture of the bid security.
- (ii) An Earnest Money/Security Deposit (EMD) of 2% of the total cost of the work in the form of a DD from Nationalized / Scheduled bank drawn in favour of "PD Centre for BRSD As a CoE" Payable at "Kimin" from a nationalized/scheduled bank, shall be paid as directed in NIT.
- (iii) Amount or amounts payable, if any, to the bidder or the bid security furnished by the bidder in respect of an earlier bid, shall not be adjustable against this bid.
- (iv) The amount deposited as EMD/bid security shall carry no interest during the entire period it remains with DBT-APSCS&T CoE for Bioresources and Sustainable Development, Department of Science & Technology, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Kimin.
- (v) The Earnest Money Deposit of the unsuccessful tenderer will be refunded without interest within reasonable time after final decision of the tender, normally within six months from the date of opening of tenders against the request letter.

- (vi) The Earnest Money/Security Deposit of the successful bidder will also be returned without interest within reasonable time after final decision of the tender, normally after warranty period against the request letter.
- (vii) The bid security (EMD) shall be forfeited:
 - (a) If the bidder withdraws his bid during the period of bid validity; or
 - (b) In the case of a successful bidder, if the bidder fails to sign the contract and/or fails to furnish after sales service during warranty period in accordance to the relevant clauses of the documents(s).

A bid not secured in accordance to the above-mentioned Clause, shall be summarily rejected as a non-responsive bid.

9. Filling of Bid Document

- (i) The Bidder's Details, Declarations and Documents in support of Eligibility Criteria shall be either typed or printed or neatly hand written and should be signed and stamped by the person duly authorized by the Bidding Company. (Please refer the checklist at Section IX)
- (ii) Violation of the above clause will lead to the rejection of the tender.

10. Submission of Bid:

The sealed bid along with the necessary documents should reach to the O/o Project Director, DBT-APSCS&T Centre of Excellence for Bioresources and Sustainable Development, Komasaki, Kimin, District Papumpare, Arunachal Pradesh-791121 on or before the Last Date. Proposal has to be submitted offline only in two bid systems i.e (i) technical bid and (ii) financial bid in their own/prescribed proforma. All the copy of documents in support of eligibility criteria etc. are also to be enclosed along with the tender documents. The list of documents to be submitted along with technical bid and financial bid are detailed in clause No.15 of Section-II of NIT Document.

11. Modification & Withdrawal of bids.

The bidder may modify or withdraw his bid after bid submission provided that the written notice of the modification/withdrawal as well as the modification/withdrawal itself is done prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of bid.

12. Summary Rejection of Bid:

One or more of the following reasons will render a bid liable to be rejected summarily: -

- (i) A bid not secured in accordance with Clause 8 of section II of the bid document.
- (ii) If DD of towards the NIT document fee is not submitted along with the bid documents.
- (iii) A Conditional bid or a bid with conditions other than those specified in the NIT documents.
- (iv) A bid received with validity for a shorter period than prescribed.
- (v) Documents establishing eligibility as per clause 2 not submitted.
- (vi) Any attempt to negotiate directly or indirectly by tenderers with the authority to whom the tender is submitted or with the authority who is competent to accept the tender or endeavors to secure interest for actual or prospective tender or to influence by any means will disqualify the tender and same will be summarily rejected.

13. Evaluation:

The evaluation process of the tender proposed to be adopted by the CoE under this clause. The purpose of this clause is only to provide the Bidders an idea of the evaluation process that CoE may adopt. However, the CoE reserves the right to modify the evaluation process at any time before the last date of submission of bids without assigning any reason, whatsoever, and without any requirement of intimating the Bidders individually of any such change.

- (i) Preliminary Examination:
 - (a) CoE will examine the bids to determine whether they are complete, whether the bid format confirms to the Tender requirements, whether any computational errors have been made, whether required EMD has been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed and whether the bids are generally in order.
 - (b) A bid determined as not substantially responsive will be rejected by CoE and may not subsequently be made responsive by the Bidder by correction of the nonconformity.
 - (c) CoE may waive any informality or non-conformity or irregularity in a bid which does not constitute a material deviation according to the Bidder, provided such waiver does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any Bidder.

- (ii) Clarification

When deemed necessary, during the tendering process, the CoE may seek clarifications or ask the Bidders to make technical presentations on any aspect from any or all the Bidders. However, that would not entitle the Bidder to change or cause any change in the substance of the tender submitted or price quoted.

- (a) Technical bids will be further evaluated only for the Bidders who succeed the pre-qualification criterion.
- (b) Bid evaluation committee will review the Technical bids of the short-listed Bidders to determine whether the Technical bids are substantially responsive. Bids that are not substantially responsive are liable to be disqualified.
- (c) Bid evaluation committee will assign points (Technical Score) to the technically qualified Bidders. Based on the Technical evaluation criterion the Commercial/ Financial bids for the technically qualified Bidders will then be opened and reviewed to determine whether the Commercial/ Financial bids are substantially responsive.
- (d) The evaluation will be made on the basis of quality - cum – cost.
- (e) The bidder(s) shall not be permitted to make corrections after opening of bid to make such bid(s) substantively responsive.
- (f) The purchaser is not bound to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves the right to accept the whole or any part of the tender and of allotting the quantities offered. The bidders shall supply the quantities as decided by the purchaser at the approved rates.
- (g) The purchaser may waive minor non-conformance or irregularity(s) in a bid, which does not constitute a material deviation, provided such a waiver does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of the bid(s).

(iii) Technical Evaluation Criteria

The following criteria shall be used to evaluate the Technical Bids. **All the bids scoring 70 and above in the Technical evaluation will be qualified for Commercial/ Financial bid opening.**

14. Commercial Evaluation of Substantively Responsive Bids:

On the bid opening day mentioned in the NIT only the technical bids will be opened which will be evaluated for responsiveness. Financial bids of those bidders whose technical bids are found to be responsive only will be opened and commercially evaluated, on a same date.

15. Documents comprising the bid

The submitted bid document shall comprise the following components: -

A. Technical Bid:-PART-A

Technical Bid should contain the complete specifications and technical details required for evaluation of the tender and the equipment's offered. Following details should invariably form part of the technical bid.

- (i) Bidder's Detail duly filled (as per section VIII).
- (ii) EMD - 2% of Total Cost of the Work.
- (iii) Cost of the tender document i.e., document fee.
- (iv) Documentary evidence established in accordance with clause 2 that the bidder is eligible to bid and is qualified to perform the contract if his bid is accepted. The following documents are to be enclosed with.
 - (a) Self-attested copy of Certificate of Incorporation from Registrar of Companies in respect of clause 2(i) of Section II
 - (b) Self-attested copy of Article/Memorandum of Association of the Company in respect of clause 2(i) of Section II
 - (c) Certificate from CA stating the Annual Turnover for last Three Financial Years.

In case of any break down during warranty period for more than seven days, the period of warranty will be extended by the period of break down during the warranty period.
- (ii) The defects, if any, during the warranty period are to be rectified free of charges to CoE, by arranging free replacement wherever necessary.

17. Disputes and Arbitration
