Arunachal Pradesh State Council for Science and Technology in collaboration with the Botanical Survey of India observed “Van Mahotsav” Day (Forest Day) on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2024 at Arunachal Pradesh Science Centre. Dr. Krishna Chawlu, Scientist E BSI Itanagar delivered a lecture on the importance of our planet Shri C.D.Mungyak, Director cum member secretary , APSCS&amp;T and Shri K. Althaf Ahmed Kabeer Scientist E &amp; Head of BSI Itanagar office also attended and spoke on the occasion. .</li><li>2. Arunachal Pradesh Science Centre, APSCS&amp;T, observed World Zoonoses Day on 6<sup>th</sup> July 2024. An interaction programme with the resource person, Dr. Nido Tayo, MVSC (Surgery and Radiology), Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Dispensary, Itanagar followed by a Poster Exhibition was conducted as a part of the programme. Students from PI Academy, Itanagar and members Pet owners of ICR joined the programme. The basic idea of the programme was to emphasize the critical intersection of human and animal health.</li><li>3. An online meeting with the National Research Development Corporation (NRDC), New Delhi on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2024. The meeting focused on providing technical support and guidance for IPR protection, technology transfer and commercialization of the technologies being developed by DBT-APSCS&amp;T CoE for BRSD, Kimin. During the meeting, NRDC proposed for organizing a one day National innovation meet in Arunachal Pradesh during latter part of the year. This meet aims to provide a platform for researchers, industry experts, innovations and explore potential collaborations in the State with NRDC and other scientific, academic institutions. NRDC agreed to support the CoE in all possible aspects and proposed signing a memorandum of agreement (MoA) for technical collaboration with the CoE.</li><li>4. On 13<sup>th</sup> July 2024 NN Charitable Trust visited Arunachal Pradesh Science Centre, exploring its Innovation Hub and Robotics facilities. The visit aimed to introduce the group to the latest advancements in Science and Technology, fostering interest and knowledge in these fields.</li><li>5. On 21<sup>st</sup> July 2024 Shri Mihin Doilang, a renowned grassroots innovator from the National Innovation foundation of India, conducted a site inspection in Khachi Nyelam Village. The visit was undertaken to evaluate the proposed location for installing a large cardamom Dryer.</li></ol>
