## 8<sup>th</sup> March: International Women's Day

## **22<sup>nd</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup> March: Training Programme**

3 days training programme was organized in virtual mode on the topic “Development of **Eco-friendly Handmade Paper & Paper board from Bamboo and other lingo cellulosic raw materials available in N.E. region**”. The training programme has been organized by Kumarappa National Handmade Paper Institute, Jaipur, Rajasthan in virtual mode at Science Centre, Itanagar. Around 35 participants have attended the training. In this training the importance of handmade paper and knowledge on raw materials used for handmade paper making, eco-friendly pulping methods, beating methods, natural dyes method were taught. Information on Handmade Paper machinery specifications and design layout were also given. Information on Biotechnological application on handmade paper making was also provided. For the entrepreneurial take up of handmade Paper making unit, information on productions, domestic and export markets procedure, loan schemes for setting up of the unit were also provided.



## **26- 27 March: Workshop on LED Bulb**

Two days' workshop on LED bulb manufacturing and repairing organized at Arunachal Pradesh Science Centre, Itanagar. It is an initiative by "Let's Light Arunachal" in collaboration with APSC (APSCS&T), Itanagar.

The objective was to train the participants in assembling and repairing LED bulbs and thus help them become self-reliant in the field of energy efficiency. Participants can manufacture these lights on their own for generating livelihood after the training. This program will not only help in providing employment but will also be helpful in making people realize the importance of energy saving devices such as the use of LED bulbs in their daily lives. A total of 29 participants participated in the 2-d day workshop.

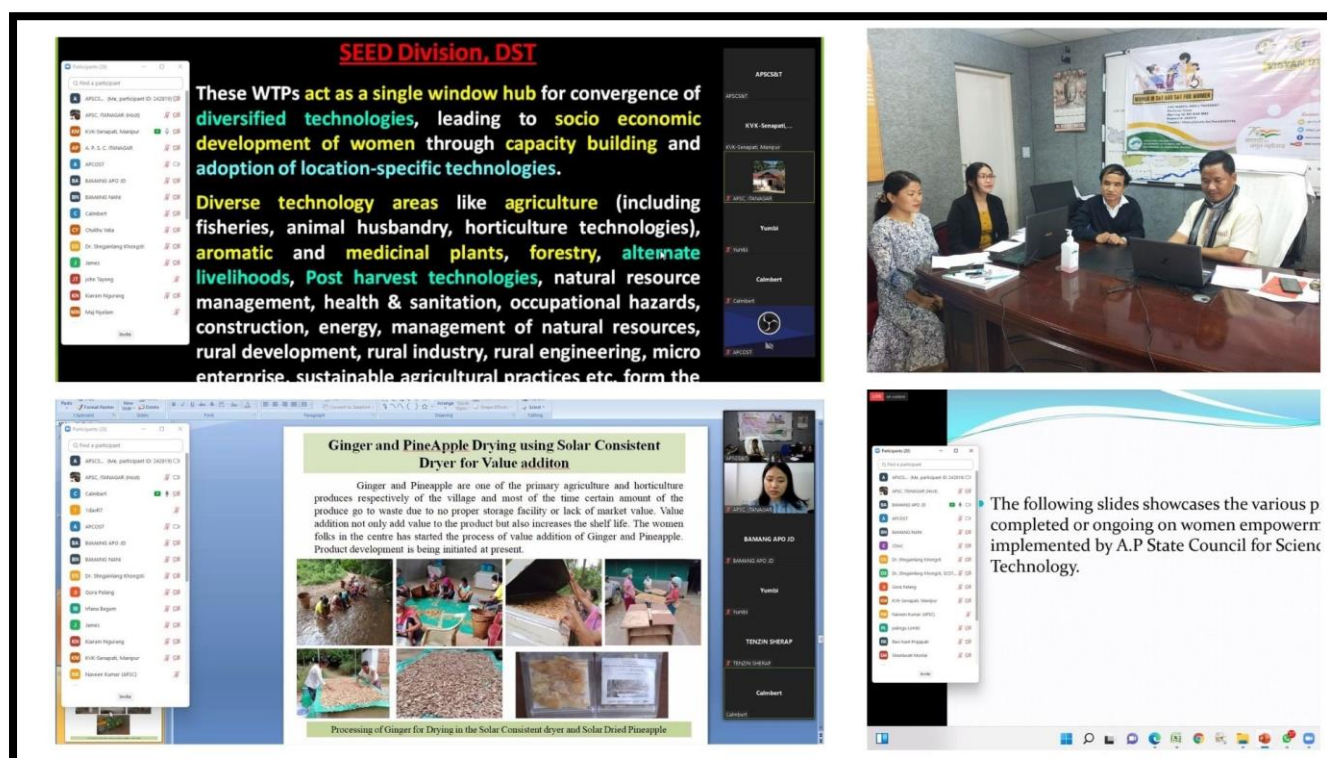


## 31<sup>st</sup> March: Vigyan Utsav
